Applications can be made from 15th November for a primary school place for September 2019. You must apply for your child's school place by 15th January 2019 for primary school admissions in September 2019.



Puffin Class will be leading our Advent Assembly on Thursday 29th November. All parents, carers, grandparents and friends are welcome to attend from 9.15am.




School Jumpers

Thank you to everyone who helps support our PTFA events which help raise funds for the school to purchase Chromebooks, events and treats for our children.




MR BUNNY'S CHOCOLATE FACTORY
