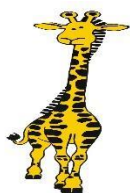


Our Lady's Catholic Primary School September Plan



This document is to explain the arrangements for when we return to school on **Wednesday 8th September**. The actions below are not exhaustive and will be constantly reviewed.

Please talk through the ideas in this document with your children to help prepare them for coming back to school.

	What we are doing
Breakfast and After-school clubs.	<p>Breakfast and After School clubs will continue to run.</p> <p>Breakfast will be offered for those children who want it. There will be an additional charge for this.</p> <p><u>Breakfast club charges:</u></p> <p>With breakfast £5.00 Without breakfast £4.50</p> <p>7.45am to 8.45am</p> <p><u>After-school club charges:</u></p> <p>3-15pm - 4.15pm - £4.50 3-15pm - 5.15pm - £8.50</p>
School start and finish times:	<p>All children in the main school will start at 8.45am and finish at 3.15pm.</p> <p>Barn-a-bs will be from 9am to 3pm.</p>
Lunch and Breaks	<p>Children from different classes will be able to mix during breaktime and lunchtimes.</p> <p>KS1 and KS2 will have separate breaks.</p> <p>Lunch will be split into mixed key stage groups.</p> <p>First sitting will be Robins (R) , Heron (Y1), Owls (Y3) and Kingfisher (Y5).</p>

	<p>The second sitting will be Puffins (Y2), Eagles (Y4) and Swallows (Y6).</p> <p>Family dining service will resume. Children going into Y3 will now have to pay for their school dinners unless they are entitled to free school meals.</p> <p>There will be an option of an internal lunchtime provision based around mindfulness activities.</p>
Entrances and Exits	<p>There will be specific entry and exit routes for each class. Each of the entrances will be staffed to help a smooth transition in and out of school.</p> <p>Barn-a-bs: Enter the school as usual through the front entrance and a member of staff will meet you at the BBs gate.</p> <p>Reception: Enter through the front entrance of the school and then into school through the back of the hall.</p> <p>Y1: Enter school from the back gate and make your way to the Heron class.</p> <p>Y2: Enter school from the back gate and make your way to the Puffin class.</p> <p>Y3: Enter school from the back gate and make your way to the Owl class.</p> <p>Y4: Enter school from the back gate and make your way to the Eagle class.</p> <p>Y5: Enter school from the front gate and make your way around to the entrance by the staff room.</p> <p>Y6: Enter school from the front gate and make your way around to the entrance by the staff room.</p> <p>The handover of children will take place outside of the classroom with the class teacher or teaching assistant. Please prepare your children for this.</p>
Uniform	<p>Children are expected to wear the school uniform including a tie.</p> <p>Please see previous newsletters for a full list of uniform requirements.</p> <p>School uniforms should be pre-ordered and paid for on</p>

	<p>scopay. Uniforms can be picked up from school on Monday 6th and Tuesday 7th from 10am.</p> <p>Children should come to school in their P.E kits on the days they have P.E. P.E days for the Autumn Term are as follows:</p> <p>Robins - Tuesday & Friday Hérons - Tuesday & Friday Puffins- Monday & Thursday Owls - Monday & Friday Eagle - Tuesday & Thursday Kingfisher - Monday & Tuesday Swallow - Monday & Thursday</p>
Sanitising and Cleaning	Every room in the school will have a box with cleaning products.
	On entry in the morning, children will wash their hands. Children will wash their hands throughout the day including before they leave to go home.
Learning	<p>During the first two weeks back our main curriculum focus will be on children's wellbeing; talking about worries, friendships and generally reassuring children.</p> <p>There will be a series of enrichment activities and tasks as well as some light touch assessment in reading and maths.</p> <p>Phonics teaching will start in the first full week of the term.</p>
