# Parking

Thank you all for your continued patience with the parking restrictions around school. It is important that parents and visitors to the school continue to park considerately and legally.

If anyone does receive a parking ticket or are subject to any unreasonable contact with our neighbours, please let the school know so that we can keep a record of these.

Mr Meech has requested a meeting with parents and Councillor Brian Greenslade but we are still awaiting a response from him.

Mr Cox, MP for Torridge who represents some of our parents has been written to recently, his response to this is as follows:-

'Mr Cox has requested further clarification regarding the traffic enforcement officers maintaining a balance with parents parking at the school and reassurance that parents would not be fined between 8.45am and 9.15 am and 3pm. The County Council are unable to provide such an assurance. As indicated above, the approach operated will depend on Parents behaving responsibly and not parking in an obstructive fashion when ensuring that their children are escorted to the school and picked up safely. It is hoped that this approach is clear and parents will not be at risk of receiving a Penalty Charge Notice if they follow these guidelines. '
