



We are delighted to have lots of new two year olds joining us. We will be completing a two year old review for your child, as part of our statutory requirements. We will aim to do this within 6 weeks of your child starting with us. The health visitor will also do a 2 year old review. This is usually done at around 2 years and 3 months, ask your doctor if you have not had one yet. These statutory reviews ensure that education and health work together to support your family.

We are closed on the 8th June for the general election, as the school is used as a polling station. These closure days are factored in to our yearly calendar. We are required to be open for 38 weeks. You will have received a letter and calendar regarding these dates, but please come in and talk to us if you have any questions.

Many parents have uploaded some brilliant photos to tapestry. These observations are really helpful to us. We can talk to your child, look at the photos together and it makes your child feel special to have their home life valued and shared at school. We are making a display of some of the photos we have received in the past. This display has a science theme, so please send us photos, via tapestry, of your child exploring the environment (garden, woods, beach etc), or cooking, or using technology.
