Reading

A lot of reading in school takes place within teaching sequences. Please encourage your child to read everyday reinforcing phonics to enable them to blend sounds. If your child is struggling, read them a story in order to help develop their story language. Children benefit from exploring the same story more than once.

A recent study showed that children without books at home are 15 times less likely to be good readers than their book owning peers.

Topic

Our Autumn topic is...



Earth from space

For the first half of the Autumn term we will be focusing on history and famous historians. We will learn about Neil Armstrong and the moon landing.

The second half of term will focus more on Geography, looking at Earth from space. We will learn about where we live, the seven continents, different countries within those continues etc.

English

Our English sessions will explore a range of different texts. We will start the term looking at the fictional story, The Gingerbread Man and then lead onto a non-fiction piece of instruction writing.



Maths

Your child will be working at their own level on place value, addition and subtraction and geometry. In addition to maths lessons they will complete daily number work.

Science

We will be learning about different materials and seasonal changes.

RE

We will be using our CAST scheme. This term our units are Creation, Prayer, Saints and Feasts, Sacraments, Advent and Christmas.

PE

We are having the company Sporting World coming into school to teach us Physical Education. This typically happens on a Monday and Friday morning.

Computing

We will start the term by focusing on online safety. Later we will explore algorithms and programming.

Music

When our risk assessment allows (Covid-19), we will have our specialist music teacher coming into class to enrich the children's musical ability.

PSHE & RHE

We will learn about new beginnings, behaviour for learning and aspirations.
