

## Barn-a-b's at Our Lady's



Welcome back to Barn-a-b's after the half term break – we hope you all enjoyed some quality family time and made some memories with your children. We've seen some great

photos on Tapestry that the children are sharing with their Barn-a-buddy.

We are continuing our topic of Traditional Tales and this week have looked at the 3 Little Pigs in line with the whole school. Why don't you see if your child can re-tell the story with you at home...?

As you may be aware, the 30 hours of funding for 3 & 4 year olds, with parents working 16+ hours a week, is being launched in September. We are waiting for the final details from Devon before we can give you all the information but we will be participating and hope some families will benefit from this extended provision.

The children are really enjoying the daily session of letter and sounds. We are following the Jolly Phonics programme and you can find actions and songs on YouTube if you want to have a go with your child at home.

Lastly, an early warning...if you have a child who will be starting school in September and you need to use Barn-a-b's in the afternoons for the settling in period, please let us know in the office and we will make sure we can accommodate all the children. Thank you.
