Universal Funding in the EYFS at Our Lady's Catholic Primary School

Barn-a-bs Pre School receive funding of £4.02 for all 3 and 4 year olds. This is made up of ± 3.98 + an extra 4p for 'Universal Funding'. The purpose for of this extra 4p is to support the children who need extra help to access the curriculum.

At Our Lady's we are committed to spending the Universal Funding in the following ways:

Increased adult support	Our aim is to have more than just the
	required amount of staff on hand to
	support our children make the most of their

	ensure that ALL children have access to
	high quality provision.
Training	All support staff in Barn-a-bs have access to
	excellent CPD. This could involve specialist
	courses but also time for reflection and
	supervision. Example of training includes;
	Sensory breaks, supporting children with
	autism, speech & language support and the
	Primary Writing Project.
Resources	Our EYFS benefits from excellent resources,
	designed to stimulate learning and create
	inquisitive minds.
External support	Staff and families have access to the
	school's SEND co-ordinator and Educational
	Psychologist. This support enables key
	workers to create My Plans for their
	children as well as more formal reporting,
	should we need to apply for further funding
	to support individual children.
