Change to Uniform

From September all children will be expected to wear a tie as part of their school uniform.

For girls, this should be worn with a white collared shirt (short or long sleeved) and for boys this should be worn with a blue collared shirt (short or long sleeved). The ties are navy clip-ons (for Recep-Y5) and Tie Your Own Navy Ties for Y6. These are now in stock and available to purchase from the school for £4.

The following items of uniform are only available via school:

School jumpers (£14.50 or £15.50), PE T-Shirts (£7), PE Hoodies (£15), PE Kit Bags (£5), Navy Backpacks (£15) or Book Bags (£5) - all with the school logo on (apart from the jumpers)

Items are available to purchase from the school office with payment being made via Scopay. Please ask the school office for a log in for Scopay if you have not already set up an account.

Some items are currently out of stock in school but a delivery from our suppliers will be made during the summer holiday. The Admin Team are available in school on the two non pupil days of Monday 6th and Tuesday 7th September if you would like to collect any uniform during school hours on these days.

It would greatly assist the Admin Team if you could order and pre-pay for items required on Scopay or by bringing cash to the school office next week so that we can have your order ready for collection on those days in September.
