These children demonstrate the values of being a British citizen. They make the most of their opportunities in




school using their voice to help others and engage fully in the life of the school.

Well done to Paige Thomson who was awarded a badge and certificate for completing the British Level 5 Gymnastic Trampolining Award.


Congratulations to Cody Wonnacott who received a Football Medal for Supporting his Team at a recent cup match.


