Feedback from Parent Questionnaire

In the parent questionnaire a question was raised about how parents can keep in touch with what is going on in school and with their child's learning.

There are many ways you can find out about your child's time in school. These include; Class Dojo, parent information sheets, parentmail, tapestry (Barn a Bs and Robins only), parents evening meetings, the school website, class open morning and by appointment with the teacher.

Whilst all teachers endeavour to make themselves available at the start of the day for quick messages or concerns, often there may not be enough time to deal with these properly. If this is the case an appointment can be made through the office to arrange either a face to face appointment or a telephone call.

The school website is full of information about the school (www.ourladys.devon.sch.uk). Each class have their own page full of information about the learning happening in class, accompanied by lots of photos! You will find parent information sheets and class homework on here too.


