



#### **The Big Pedal**

Get active with us for Sustrans Big Pedal. For the first time, walking will be counted alongside cycling and scooting. This year the challenge will run from 25 March—5 April and the miles completed will count towards traveling around different parts of the body on a big body map.

On each day of the challenge, schools will compete to see who can record the greatest number of pupils, staff and parents cycling, walking, scooting or using a wheelchair to school. Our best five days will determine our final position. All schools will be entered into daily prize draws for rewards if over 15% of the school cycle, walk or scoot on each day of the challenge. Prizes up for grabs include accessories and equipment to help our school travel actively.
