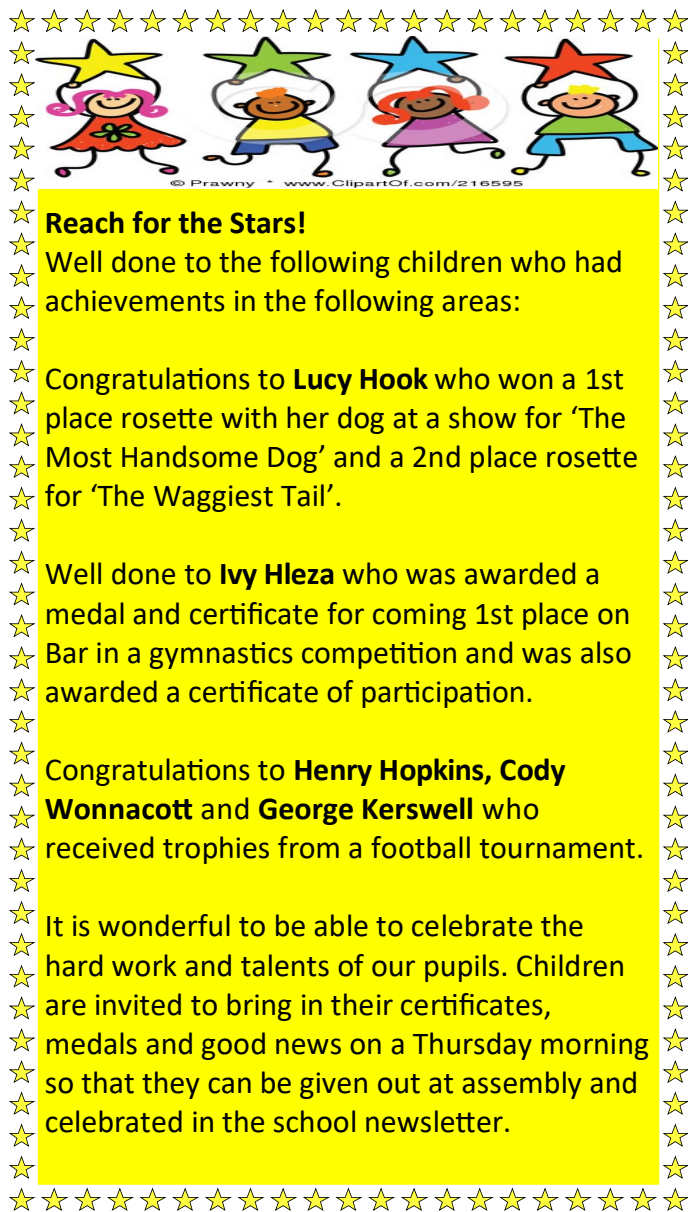
## New School Uniform Items
