TOPIC

Our topic for this term is 'The Rainforest'. This is an incredibly exciting topic in which the children will discover exotic plant and animal life. It is geography based and so the children will use maps and chrome books to locate countries and environmental regions. The children will learn the different levels of the rainforest, compare and contrast habitats and study the impact of deforestation.

ENGLISH

This term we will begin a new English sequence based on the story 'The Papaya That Spoke'. This is a comical story in which the children will study, learn and innovate in order to create their own adaptation. Their grammatical focus is to use speech punctuation correctly and to use a range of conjunctions to make their writing more interesting. Focus for the second half of the term is to be confirmed.

Our first class book is the Sheep-Pig by Dick King-Smith. We will read this altogether with discussions and opportunities to share throughout. We will also share a range of poetry and non-fiction texts.

MATHS

This term we move forward from addition and subtraction to multiplication and division. They will learn how to solve problems mentally and using written methods. They will learn to solve problems involving those with missing numbers. All children will be working at their own level within maths. We are focusing on the 3, 4 and 8 times tables.

SCIENCE

The children will begin this term being personal trainers under the title curriculum title 'Animals As Humans'. The class has been split into teams, each with their own client in which they need to advise about their diet and exercise in order to become healthier and happier. For the second half term the children will learn about light and shadow.

RE

For the first half term, the children will continue with Christmas with the title Epiphany before moving on to revelations.

After half term the children learn about lent in the lead up to Easter before moving on to Holy week.

PE

This term Sporting World continue to teach our children a new focus of gymnastics. We will also be enjoying swimming lessons on a Wednesday afternoon. We will be walking to the swimming pool each week so please ensure you send your children to school with a waterproof coat and warm accessories.

COMPUTING

We will explore communication and networks, e-safety, algorithms and programming and development.
