

The PTFA are committed to raising funds for the school and your children.


Ash Wednesday School Service

Please be aware that we will be holding an Ash Wednesday service in the school hall at 11am on Wednesday 1st March. As a result of this there will be no Prayer and Praise next week.

All parents, carers, grandparents and friends are most welcome to attend this service.

Lent

Lent is a time for reconciliation and of growing closer to God. It is a time for doing something positive and, as is our Catholic tradition, the children and staff focus on:



Prayer—spending more time with God.

Alms-giving—Giving to those who have very little or sharing what you have with someone who needs it. **Sacrificing**—Giving up something that you really like.

This year our main focus is on strengthening the prayer life of ourselves and the school, look out for future newsletters with information on how you may be involved.

On Friday the 10th March the school will take part in the CAFOD Lenten Fast Day by eating a very simple lunch. Lunch for the whole school will be soup and bread, with fruit for dessert. The cost of this meal to KS2 children will be £1.50 but we encourage families to pay the normal £2.20, so that a 70p donation from each meal goes to support the work of CAFOD. KS1 families are encouraged to make a donation towards the meal on that day.

Further details of the CAFOD Family Fast Day will be sent home shortly.
