PE

Accelerated Reader (AR)

As they move up through the school, questions of inference and "reading between the lines" are particularly useful, as well as looking at the structure and presentation of non-fiction texts.

Homework

Spellings have started again this week and will continue throughout the term. Other homework will start next week, set on a Wednesday, to be handed in on Monday. If homework is a bit of a struggle, don't forget homework club on Wednesdays after school, where you can get all your homework completed in a quiet

and purposeful hour, with a teacher on hand to help if needed.

If your child does not know all their times tables up to 12 x 12, it is vital that this knowledge is secured as soon as possible. We will be working on this in class, but practice at home will also be needed, especially if your child finds this difficult. Various apps and games are available to help your child learn these facts.

Topic Learning

Our topic for this term is Barnstaple Past and Present. We will be looking at the history of our town from earliest times and hope to go exploring around the town.
