I am really excited to share this year's whole school topic. With plenty of recent conversation around David Attenborough's Blue Planet and focus on how we treat the Earth, we shall be picking apart the Pope's letter named Laudato Si and thinking how, as the new generation, we can help guide the children into being more sustainable citizens. The children will receive a homework sheet that has a number of exciting projects on that they can complete in their time. Many lessons in the classroom will tie in with our new topic.

This term in Maths, we move on to Fractions and Decimals, followed by Measurement and Shape. Lots of activities involving Fractions and Shape can be learnt through fun, practical activities at home too. E.g. eating pizzas and cake and cutting them into halves and quarters. Also, we will continue to look at our times tables to secure them mentally! During June, the children will have a trail times table test that will begin officially as of next year. It is extremely important that they continue to work on them. I have included many different websites on the Class Dojo feed and urge you to continue using them. Keep up the great work!

Our English lessons will focus on our Laudato Si Topic and we will be using a range of fiction and non-fiction texts to help us create our own pieces of extended writing.

In RE, we will begin by learning more about the Easter Story. Pentecost will follow as will looking further into different religions around the world.
