

Changes to our Scopay On-line Payment System
Changes are being made by credit card companies
such as WorldPay to improve the security of their
systems. As a result, any parents using Windows XP
or Windows Vista will no longer be able to use
Tucasi Online Payments.

## Why is this happening?

This change is being enforced by the PCI DSS (Payment Card Industry Data Security Standard). From the 30th June 2018 all websites that accept card payments will no longer allow users of Windows XP and Windows Vista to use their websites. WorldPay are implementing this change on **30th April 2018**.

This change is outside of Tucasi's control and is not limited to Tucasi Online Payments.

If you experience any difficulties logging onto the Scopay system to pay for Breakfast Club, After School Club or school dinners then please see a member of the Admin Team.


Well done to **Riley Yates** who was awarded a football trophy.
