Remote Learning:

Children are required to self-isolate for Covid-19 symptoms. The office will alert the class teacher.



Class teacher will make contact with the parents to outline how they will support the child with their home-learning.



Work will be set using google classrooms. It will consist of a Maths task, an English Task, a Reading activity and one other lesson. If possible the work should mirror the learning taking place in class.



Teacher will remain in contact with the child/ parents via google classroom/dojo. Where possible speak to the child via phone regularly. Report any concerns in the usual way. Continue to use dojo to praise remote learning.



If the child does not have any online access at home, either a Chromebook will be delivered to the house or paper copies will be made available. Establish this in the initial contact with the parent.



On return consider the need for any shortterm intervention during lessons to support any learning covered in the child's absence.



In the event of a cohort or whole school lockdown, learning will be delivered via google classroom with the same expectations as mentioned above.
