## TOPIC

In the next couple of weeks we will begin our new topic, 'Night at the Museum'. This topic is art based.

Through this art topic, we'll be finding out about:

- The work of artists, craft makers and designers
- Using a range of materials to design and make products
- Drawing, painting and sculpture to develop and share ideas, experience and imagination
- Develop a wide range of art and design techniques

## ENGLISH

Our main texts are Little Red Riding Hood by Pie Corbett, The Dragon Machine by Helen Ward and . Spelling rules and phonics are taught daily and children are **encouraged to practise spellings at home** and well as spelling common exception words.

## MATHS

Your child will be working at their own level on number sense, multiplicative reasoning, additive reasoning and geometric reasoning. They will also complete weekly arithmetic assessments.

## SCIENCE

We will looking to describe how plants and seeds grow.

## PSHE

We will be exploring British Values as well as Going for Goals.

## RE

We will be using our 'God Matters' scheme. This term our units are Easter, Pentecost and Mission and other faiths.

## PE

We continue to use the company Sporting World coming into school to teach us Physical Education. This term they will be doing tag rugby. Please ensure your child has a full PE kit every Monday and Wednesday.

## MUSIC

Through our music teacher Mrs Hynes we will be learning about musical terms through percussion.

## HISTORY AND GEOGRAPHY

We will be look at art through history and the geographical features in the art where appropriate.

## COMPUTING

We will explore communication and networks, e-safety, algorithms and programming and development. The children will be using ICT to organise, classify and present information. We will also be exploring and learning to use programmes on the computer properly i.e. Word, patterns using Paint and Mathletics.
