TOPIC

The class are currently concluding their rainforest topic which has been absolutely fascinating! We will then have a mini geography based topic focused on wonderful water around the world. Encompassing it's importance, it's shortage, where it is found and how it supports communities. After half term we move onto our very exciting art and design topic. The Owl class is very lucky to have two teachers as they will have two different aspects to learn and study. The first is a natural perspective and the second is studying the work on Bridget Riley. An English artist famous for her 'Op Art.'

ENGLISH

This term be begin with a text called 'The Canal' It is a warning story and taught in the same way as previously, using the primary writing project. We learn the text, then innovate as a class before the children have a go at writing their own version. The focus for this story is to recap using speech correctly as well as using appropriate vocabulary for the type of text. Our second text will be non-fiction which is to be confirmed.

Our class book to begin this term is called 'The Abominable' by Eva Ibbotson. We are already really enjoying it!

MATHS

Maths this term begins with fractions. We have already been revising what the children already know before moving on to counting in 10ths. Other focus's this term are geometry, measures and statistics.

SCIENCE

The children are finishing their focus on 'light' over the next few days before moving on to rocks. After half term the class will focus on plants which will also tie in well with the natural aspects of the art topic.

RE

RE this term begin with learning about Easter and the ascension of Jesus to heaven. Other RE topics this term include: Pentecost and mission, Prayer Saints and Feasts and other religions such as Judaism, Hinduism and Sikhism.

PE
