Subject	Expectation	Information for this week
Reading	<p>2x RWI books sent home each week to be read daily.</p> <p>A share together story book to be sent home weekly.</p>	<p>Children should read their RWI reading books daily throughout the week; we suggest 5-10 mins per day. Reading a book more than once helps children to build fluency and comprehension skills. Before reading the book, children should practice their sounds, green words and red words at the front of the book. Please write in the reading diary the date and any comments about your children's reading.</p>
Phonics and Spellings	<p>RWI virtual classroom videos sent home each week to match sounds taught in class.</p> <p>Sound focus sheets each week to match the sounds taught in class.</p>	<p>Children should watch the virtual classroom videos each week to consolidate their sound knowledge and learning from in class that week.</p> <p>Children should complete any sound practice sheets sent home each week. These are assigned to support children to practice their sound knowledge from in class that week, or to revisit previous sounds.</p>
Maths	<p>1x online activity or 1x activity sheet each week</p>	<p>This activity will be chosen to reinforce learning from in class that week. This may be an activity sheet or on an online platform such as Numbots. Power Maths or Top Marks.</p>
	<p>Activities will be sent home at different times throughout the year to support children's learning in class.</p>	<p>At some points through the year I will send home some learning / ideas of things to do with your child linked to their learning surrounding understanding of the world or expressive art design. These may be practical suggestions or creative based activities.</p>
