Subject	Expectation	Information for this week
Reading	20 mins at least 3 x a week	Reading your school reading book and then any other text you would like to read or share with an adult at home. Please write in your reading diary the date, what has been read and to what page so this can be followed on at school. We are still working through our own reading assessments so your child's book band may change quickly, including moving onto Accelerated Reader (AR).
Phonics and Spellings	X 1 weekly piece	Spellings will be sent home every week. Please practise them.. Also if you write any stories please bring them in so we can celebrate them.
Maths (Times Tables)	1x weekly piece Timestables practise	The activity will be chosen to reinforce learning from in class that week. This may be an activity sheet or on an online platform from Maths flex. Practice times tables on ttrackstars. It is important that children have a fast recall of their times tables so not only will they be ready for their national times table check in Year 4 but they can use this to support their learning of new maths concepts. Please revise the 2x, 5x and 10 times table.
Foundation Subjects: Science, Art, Humanities, RE	Activities will be sent home at different times throughout the year to support children's learning in class.	These activities may take longer to complete. They will practice skills or deepen understanding of what your child is learning in class.  When the children begin a new learning sequence in History or Geography they will be sent home with a homework menu linked to their class focus. This will be a mixture of written or practical tasks to explore as a family. Children can choose which tasks interest them to have a go at completing.
