Topic

Our Summer topic is Magnificent Maps. We will be working hard on our Geography skills and learning how to read maps. In the second part of the Summer term we will hopefully be completing a whole school topic.

English

Our English sessions will explore a range of different texts.

We will start the term looking at the fictional story, Quackling and then lead onto a non-fiction piece of information text.

Later in the term we will explore the story of Pirate Tom.

Maths

Your child will be working at their own level on addition and subtraction, number and place value, multiplication and division, and measurement. In addition to maths lessons they will complete daily number work.

Science

We will be learning about plants.

RE

We will be using our Come and See scheme. The liturgical calendar will cover, Pentecost and Reconciliation.

We are having the company Sporting World coming into school to teach us Physical Education. This typically happens on a Monday and Friday morning.
