<u>P.E Days</u> This term P.E will remain on <u>Tuesday's and</u> <u>Friday's</u>. Please make sure your child has their PE kit in school!

ENGLISH

This term we begin with a text called 'Alien Landing.' It is a mystery story and taught in the same way as previously, using the Primary Writing Project. This text will then be used to cover our non-fiction focus of persuasive writing.

We will continue with our fabulous class guided reading texts, which we enjoy daily. As well as this we have our class novels. Miss Massey will continue to read *Wild Robot* and Mrs Harding will begin *Amelia Fang and the Barbaric Ball.*

MATHS

Maths this term begins with the continuation of multiplication and division from last term. This is slightly longer than usual, however we feel this key mathematical focus is so important to solidify before moving forward. The class will then move onto fractions. Other focus's this term are geometry, measures and statistics.

SCIENCE

We begin this term with an investigation study into *plant*. Using sturdy broad beans, we will experiment with what happens when some of the key life sources are taken. Within this, we will focus on the structure of plants and how water is transported. Around plants.

RE

RE this term begins with learning Hinduism before moving on to Pentecost and learning about the Holy Spirit. After half-term the class will move on to reconciliation; focusing on choices and forgiveness and then finishing with CAFOD– special places.

HUMANITIES

As Geographers and Historians the Owls Class will be learning about Vikings. They will be using atlases and maps to locate where the Vikings lived. The class have shown a great interest in Viking Gods and so this will be followed. Using a range sources, the Owls will learn about Viking lifestyle and how they became so legendry.

PE

The Owl class have begun this term with continuing with volleyball before moving on to athletics. Remember, PE is on a Tuesday and Friday so please make sure children have their PE kits on these days
